The ASUNM Senate hereby establishes the ASUNM Emergency Scholarship. This scholarship will serve as an avenue for students to come to ASUNM and request money when unforeseen circumstances occur that impact their ability to obtain higher education. Students will request this scholarship in the form of a short application process, address the issue they are facing and how this scholarship will assist them.

ASUNM is awarding twenty (10) \$250 scholarships for undergraduate students that are selected by the ASUNM Scholarship Committee and meet the below criteria. **The scholarships will be awarded in two different rounds during the Spring 2021 semester.** The first deadline to submit the application is Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. The second round deadline will be April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

1. Any student applying for the scholarship must, at the time of application and award, meet the following qualifications: be a student of the University of New Mexico (any undergraduate or a non-degree student who has not received a baccalaureate degree). The student will have attended UNM for at least one semester prior to application, with at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and be a full time student at UNM, with twelve (12) credit hours minimum.
2. All ASUNM Officials (elected or appointed), employees, and agents of ASUNM are permitted to apply for and/or receive these scholarships.
3. All Applications must be emailed to [asunm@unm.edu](mailto:asunm@unm.edu) no later than 5:00 p.m. on

Monday, April 5th, 2021.
