Bill automatically becomes law. 17 18 19 **Legislative Response:** Veto override vote taken: Senate Action: 20 21 22 Summary: Changes the duties of a Senator from holding two (2) weekly Office Hours and 23 twelve (12) semesterly Outreach Hours to one (1) weekly Office Hour, one (1) weekly 24 Outreach Hour, and eight (8) semesterly ASUNM Event Hours. 25 26 Be it enacted by the Associated Students at the University of New Mexico that the following be 27 amended in (Legislative Code) of the ASUNM (Law Book): 28 29 Section 2. Duties of each a Senator serving on the ASUNM Senate 30 A. Each Senator is required to attend Standing Committee meetings and Full 31 32 Senate meetings for the entire duration of the meeting. 33 B. Each senator is required to hold at least two (2) one (1) Senatorial Office Hours a week, which will be held in the ASUNM office. It is mandatory that each 34 35 Senator submit **proof of attendance for** their Office Hours each weekly. The 36 date and time of the submission will be at the discretion of the President Pro 37 Tempore each semester. 38 C. If a Senator is unable to complete their office hours Office Hour during their 39 stated times, they need to contact the President Pro Tempore before the designated time of their office hours Office Hour. If a Senator is unable to 40 41 attend their Standing Committee meetings or Full Senate meetings, they need to contact the President Pro Tempore at least twenty-four (24) hours before the 42 43 meeting is scheduled. The President Pro Tempore will then immediately notify

44		the committee chair and the Vice President of the senator's absence. In case of
45		an emergency, every effort should be made to contact the President Pro
46		Tempore within forty-eight (48) hours after the meeting or office hours, with a
47	_	written notification to excuse the absence.
48	D.	Each Senator must be appointed by the President of the Senate to one of the
49		three Senate standing Standing Committees. Those committees are the Finance
50		Committee, Outreach & Appointments and Events Committee, and the
51		Steering and Rules Committee.
52		1. The Finance Committee shall refer to the finance code Finance Code
53		and ASUNM Constitution for all financial responsibilities.
54		2. The Outreach and Appointments Events Committee shall be
55		responsible for the following outlined duties as well as what is outlined
56		in the ASUNM Constitution.
57		a. Appointments
58		i. All appointees for the positions of Chief of Staff,
59		Attorney General, Director of Communication, Director
60		of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, Student Service
61		Agency Executive Directors, and Student Court Justices
62		will be interviewed by the Outreach and Appointments
63		Committee. All other appointees for positions may be
64		interviewed at the discretion of the committee.
65		a. The appointee must attend the meeting in person
66		or send another student to represent them at the
67		committee hearing.
68		b. The appointee must inform the Outreach and
69		Appointments Committee Chair at least three (3)
70		days prior to the committee meeting if another
71		student will be representing them at the
72		committee hearing.
73		c. The appointee may not send an ASUNM Senator
74		to represent them at the committee hearing.
75		ii. All appointees will be required to submit an application
76		specific to their desired position, cover letter and
77		resume.
78		a. If one or more of the documents is not presented
79		to the Outreach and Appointments Committee,
80		the appointee will not be approved until all
81		documents are received by the Outreach and
82		Appointments Committee.

83	b. If all documents are not received by the next
84	Outreach and Appointments Committee, the
85	committee must vote not to approve the
86	presidential appointment.
87	iii. If the Outreach and Appointments Committee confirms
88	the appointment, it shall be forwarded to the ASUNM
89	Senate for approval.
90	a. The candidate need not be present at full Senate.
91	b. If the candidate is not approved by the Senate,
92	the President must submit a new appointment or
93	resubmit that application.
94	iv. If the appointee is recommended for an interview with
95	the Outreach and Appointments Committee and the
96	appointee or their representative fails to attend the
97	scheduled committee hearing, the appointee or their
98	representative must attend the subsequent committee
99	hearing.
100	a. If neither the appointee nor their representative
101	attends the subsequent committee hearing and in
102	doing so has failed to attend two (2) ensuing
103	committee hearings, then the Outreach and
104	Appointments Committee must vote to not
105	approve the same presidential appointment.
106	v. The Outreach and Appointments Committee votes to
107	approve or not approve the presidential appointments
108	that are interviewed at a committee hearing.
109	vi. If an appointment is not approved by the Outreach and
110	Appointments Committee:
111	a. The President must submit a new appointment or
112	resubmit an application for the same candidate
113	within five (5) days to the Outreach and
114	Appointments Committee Chair for
115	reconsideration.
116	b. Each appointee may only be submitted twice for
117	the same position.
118	e. If an appointee is not approved after the second
119	submission, the President must submit a new
120	appointment.
121	d. If an appointment is approved by the Outreach
122	and Appointments Committee, the same process

123 for final approval by the Senate as outlined in the 124 Legislative Code Article III. Section 2. A. ii is 125 followed. 126 b. a. Outreach. 127 i. The Outreach and Appointments Events Committee 128 shall be responsible for making and posting content for 129 any dedicated ASUNM Senate social media accounts, 130 under the guidance of the Chair, and for beginning the 131 planning of specific ASUNM Senate town hall 132 initiatives. 133 ii. Further outreach responsibilities are outlined in the ASUNM Constitution and are under the discretion of the 134 135 committee and the President Pro Tempore. 136 3. The Steering and Rules Committee shall be responsible for what is 137 outlined in the ASUNM Constitution. 138 E. Senators will also serve on Student Service Agencies as appointed by the 139 President of the Senate. 140 1. Senators must contact their Student Service Agency at the beginning of 141 each semester to establish meeting times, support opportunities, and 142 provide financial assistance. Senators must continue to communicate 143 throughout their term with their assigned agency. One (1) Senator from 144 each agency shall report to Full Senate regarding the agency. 145 F. The office of the Vice President will assign a list of chartered student 146 organizations to each Senator. Senators must attempt to contact their student 147 organizations within two (2) weeks of receiving the list. 148 1. Senators must provide their assigned student organizations with the 149 Senate eOffice hHours published by the office of the Vice President. 150 G. The office of the Vice President will assign each Senator to different Resource 151 Centers. Senators must conduct a monthly meeting with a representative from 152 their respective Resource Center starting in the month they receive their 153 sponsoring Resource Center. Senators must coordinate these meetings with the 154 appropriate Joint Council representative, if applicable. 155 1. Senators must contact their Resource Center and the appropriate Joint 156 Council representative, if applicable, at the beginning of each semester 157 to establish meeting times and support opportunities. Senators must 158 continue to communicate throughout their term with their assigned 159 Resource Center and the appropriate Joint Council representative, if 160 applicable. 161 2. If a student service department on campus would like representation, 162 they shall make a request in writing with the Vice President.

163	H. Each Senator is required to complete a minimum of twelve (12) one (1)
164	Outreach hours Hour a week., with the exception of the Senators of the
165	Outreach and Appointments Committee, who are required to complete sixteen
166	(16) Outreach hours. It is mandatory that each Senator submit proof of
167	attendance for their Outreach hours Hour each week. The time and date of
168	the submission will be at the discretion of the President Pro Tempore each
169	semester.
170	1. Hours are broken down into the following categories:
171	a. Four (4) ASUNM Event Hours
172	i. Four (4) hours, completed either together or separately,
173	spent at an ASUNM approved outreach event, including
L74	but not limited to Student Service Agency hosted events,
L75	Senate planned outreach events, Executive planned
176	outreach events, or any other outreach event deemed
L77	acceptable by the President Pro-Tempore
178	b. Four (4) UNM Community Hours
L79	i. Four (4) hours, completed either together or separately,
180	spent doing any activity in line with the definition of a
181	senatorial outreach hour at a non-ASUNM sanctioned
182	event.
183	c. Four (4) Discretion Hours
184	i. Four (4) hours, completed either together or separately,
185	completed in an outreach event of the Senator's own
186	choosing including but not limited to the above approved
187	events, or any outreach event consistent with the
188	definition of an outreach hour found in the Definitions
189	Code.
190	1. By the end of each semester, a Senator is to have completed a
191	minimum of:
192	a. Fourteen (14) Outreach Hours, completed either together or
193	separately, spent doing any activity in line with the
194	definition of a Senatorial Outreach Hour.
195	i. Each Senator is to meet with each of their assigned
196	student organizations at least one (1) time.
197	a. A Senator will make contact with each student
198	organization to attend one of their meetings or
199	schedule an alternate meeting a maximum of
200	three (3) times. In the event a student
201	organization does not respond or declines a
202	meeting, the Senator shall report their attempted

203		contacts to the President Pro Tempore.
204		ii. Each Senator is to meet with their assigned Resource
205		Center at least one (1) time each semester.
206		b. Eight (8) ASUNM Event Hours, completed either together
207		or separately, spent at an ASUNM approved outreach event.
208		i. Events include but are not limited to Student Service
209		Agency hosted events and meetings, Senate planned
210		outreach events, Executive planned outreach events, or
211		any other outreach event deemed acceptable by the
212		President Pro Tempore.
213		2. The additional four (4) hours required of Outreach and Appointment
214		Senators will consist of two (2) ASUNM Event Hours and two (2)
215		UNM Community Hours.
216		2. Senators are each required to complete four (4) seven (7) Outreach
217		hHours by the onset of Fall or Spring Break to avoid disciplinary
218		action. The remaining eight (8) seven (7) hHours must be completed by
219		the final Full Senate meeting of the semester.
220		a. Outreach and Appointment Senators must complete their
221		additional four (4) hours by the final Full Senate meeting.
222	I.	Senators may be appointed to boards and committees. Senators that have
223		accepted a position in any of the preceding governing bodies are required to
224		attend all meetings for the boards and committees to which they have been
225		appointed.
226	J.	If a Senator fails to comply with the duties of their office which include but are
227		not limited to, regular attendance of office hours, committee meetings, Senate
228		meetings appointed board meetings, appointed committee meetings, or
229		outreach hours along with the proper submission of Office and Outreach
230		Credits at the Senate Pro Tempore's discretion, that Senator will face proper
231		disciplinary action as outlined by the Senator Accountability Code and the
232		ASUNM Constitution.
