

## Sports Club Funding:

- Sports Club Travel funds are only for students (no coaches or other non-competitive students).
- Graduate student participants are eligible for this funding.
- This funding is only available for sports club travel to regional qualifying or national championship tournaments at the following allocation amounts:
  - Teams of 10+ members - \$5,000 max for a national championship competition
  - Teams of less than 10 members - \$2,500 max for a national championship competition
  - Teams of 10+ members - \$2,500 max for a regional qualifying tournament
  - Teams of less than 10 members - \$1,500 max for a regional qualifying tournament
- Funding for sports club travel can be requested for flights, car rental, gas, hotel, per diem, and more.
- Any unspent funds will be reverted to the Rec Services Sports Fund at the end of the FY (June 30).
