Executive Order No. 1S Establishment of the Committee for Revision of the Elections Code

WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of New Mexico (ASUNM) is committed to upholding democratic principles, ensuring the integrity of its elections, and aligning its procedures with the mission, values, and standards of ASUNM and the University;

WHEREAS, the ASUNM Constitution and Law Book, specifically the Elections Code, requires review and updates to reflect best practices, transparency, and equitable governance;

WHEREAS, collaboration among key stakeholders will ensure a comprehensive and representative approach to reforming the Elections Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Anthony Tomaziefski, President, by the authority vested in me by the ASUNM Constitution and Law Book, do hereby order as follows:

Section 1. Establishment of the Committee for Revision of the Elections Code

- A. There is hereby established the Committee for the Revision of the Elections Code (hereafter referred to as the "CREC").
- B. The CREC shall be comprised of the following members:
 - The Attorney General (Chair)
 - The Executive Director of the Elections Commission
 - 3. One Elections Commissioner, appointed by the Elections Commissioner
 - Two Senators, appointed by the Vice President
 - 5. One Associate Justice, appointed by the Chief Justice
- C. The Attorney General shall have the power to approve or disapprove appointments.
- D. The Attorney General shall serve as the presiding member of CREC.
- E. The CREC is tasked with reviewing and proposing revisions to the relevant sections of the ASUNM Constitution and Law Book pertaining to the Elections Code.

Section 2. Objectives and Responsibilities

- A. The CREC shall:
 - 1. Conduct a thorough analysis of the current Elections Code and identify areas requiring revision.
 - Consider feedback from relevant stakeholders, including students, faculty, and administrators.
 - Develop proposed amendments to align the Elections Code with the mission, values, and procedures of ASUNM and the University.
- B. The CREC shall produce:
 - Preliminary Recommendations by February 10th, 2025.
 - Final Recommendations by February 12th, 2025, no later than 5:00 PM.

Section 3. Timeline and Implementation

- A. The CREC shall commence its work on January 21st, 2025.
- B. The CREC shall submit its final recommendations to the ASUNM Senate and Executive Branch for review and potential legislative action.



Section 4. Support and Resources

- A. The Attorney General shall ensure the CREC has access to necessary resources, including legal and procedural guidance.
- B. ASUNM shall provide administrative support to facilitate the work of the CREC.
