



1 **Executive Order No. 1S**

2 **Establishment of the Committee for Revision of the Elections Code**

3 **WHEREAS**, the Associated Students of the University of New Mexico (ASUNM) is committed to upholding democratic  
4 principles, ensuring the integrity of its elections, and aligning its procedures with the mission, values, and standards of  
ASUNM and the University;

5 **WHEREAS**, the ASUNM Constitution and Law Book, specifically the Elections Code, requires review and updates to  
6 reflect best practices, transparency, and equitable governance;

7 **WHEREAS**, collaboration among key stakeholders will ensure a comprehensive and representative approach to  
8 reforming the Elections Code;

9 **NOW, THEREFORE**, I Anthony Tomaziefski, President, by the authority vested in me by the ASUNM Constitution  
and Law Book, do hereby order as follows:

10 **Section 1. Establishment of the Committee for Revision of the Elections Code**

- 11 A. There is hereby established the Committee for the Revision of the Elections Code (hereafter referred to as the  
"CREC").
- 12 B. The CREC shall be comprised of the following members:
- 13 1. The Attorney General (Chair)
  - 14 2. The Executive Director of the Elections Commission
  - 15 3. One Elections Commissioner, appointed by the Elections Commissioner
  - 16 4. Two Senators, appointed by the Vice President
  - 17 5. One Associate Justice, appointed by the Chief Justice
- 18 C. The Attorney General shall have the power to approve or disapprove appointments.
- 19 D. The Attorney General shall serve as the presiding member of CREC.
- 20 E. The CREC is tasked with reviewing and proposing revisions to the relevant sections of the ASUNM Constitution  
and Law Book pertaining to the Elections Code.

21 **Section 2. Objectives and Responsibilities**

- 22 A. The CREC shall:
- 23 1. Conduct a thorough analysis of the current Elections Code and identify areas requiring revision.
  - 24 2. Consider feedback from relevant stakeholders, including students, faculty, and administrators.
  - 25 3. Develop proposed amendments to align the Elections Code with the mission, values, and procedures of  
ASUNM and the University.
- 26 B. The CREC shall produce:
1. **Preliminary Recommendations** by February 10th, 2025.
  2. **Final Recommendations** by February 12th, 2025, no later than 5:00 PM.

**Section 3. Timeline and Implementation**


- A. The CREC shall commence its work on **January 21st, 2025**.
- B. The CREC shall submit its final recommendations to the ASUNM Senate and Executive Branch for review and  
potential legislative action.



1 **Section 4. Support and Resources**

- 2 A. The Attorney General shall ensure the CREC has access to necessary resources, including legal and procedural  
3 guidance.  
4 B. ASUNM shall provide administrative support to facilitate the work of the CREC.
