Sri Lanka is very known for having its musical culture. We're looking to be able to rent some instruments for that, flyers can be printed pretty self explanatory, to get information out guest speakers for depending on the guest speaker, looking to bring promotional items, pretty self explanatory, and then inviting traditional dances and singers. No, I will not be singing or dance singing today because we can't, but we're looking to invite some other people that are close to our culture in order to perform

- I'm the undergrad representative of BSA Yona. And so first off, for food, we have two culture events per year that require about six months preparation each, and it happens or for both of them, sorry, and it happens every year. And we do need this food because we we have two rehearsals per week for again, six months straight, and that's very expensive. So, and those are annual, as those events happen twice per year. All right, so next up, we have ton of cartridges. These are also yearly item. It's very inconvenient to ask a

bunch of professors to print things very often, excuse me. And so we have our own and about a career cost \$47 Next up, musical instruments. So these instruments are oftentimes personal belongings, and because of the sheer amount of practice that we have to do in order to make sure that our events are very good, these instruments go through wear and tear. Ashley, for example, has to buy a new instrument. That's because he's a weeding on his own, and it takes about. And instruments don't last forever, unfortunately, and it does cost about \$700 a year to replace those instruments. All right, next up, we have our two major culture events that I alluded to earlier. So that is the International mother language date, which is actually next week. We were all invited and our picnic these do happen every single year. They're angry and cost roughly \$300 per event just for those two, just for promotions and things like that. Because, again, we need as much promotion as possible. We want to bring in as many as possible to the culture of Bangladesh and who we are. All right, so next up, we just have general office supplies for \$150 tests, paper, pens, etc, over the year. And next we have our annual magazine. So this is kind of a magazine that we all need to kind of preserve the culture of Bangladesh, because it is kind of hard to see people who are how do I say this? It's hard to like preserve the language, and we are trying everything that we can to preserve Bengali. It's a beautiful language, and we want it to last. It's a really rich culture and history. So we have a magazine to make sure that we can have and that is \$5 per and we have roughly 50 magazines printed per year next up the auditorium. We have to rent this every single year as well, just due to our events. And that is \$1,000 one advertising. We do need as much advertising as possible. So we advertise the daily logo that is roughly over dollars per year, for stage lighting, rental, sound stuff like that. We don't have our own equipments. We get to rent that annually, and that comes to roughly \$350 per so for food. Every single month we have, every single month we have meetings, just so we know what to do and just we can execute everything as perfectly as possible. So for that, we have, we were just, you know, playing playing things up, people work better. So annual food apologies. Next up we have our flyers and our brochures again, advertising that as an annual cost as well. Yeah, that's just two, yeah, \$100 and we need to close roughly next. We really need your printer, really value, because we are printing so many things again, advertising things like that. This is an enviable thing. Yeah, all right, that would be \$250 for one. Next, we have customized banners. Again, we use new banners for advertising. It's a culture thing, and it also is just kind of like patriotism for our own country, and because we're very proud of being known and next about for the paper, for that printer, that is \$95.84 for one, that's annual. That's just how much it costs to print everything that we will need to for the year, and a banner stand as well next. So this we again, we use these stands for our events, and we don't have our own. So we, we have to, we need one. Next, just a general packet binding covers.
