- Sen. Mellin: We shouldnt fund orgs at 100 percent, sets precedent for asking for more. It will be frustrating.
- Sen. Doyle: President Tomachevski said we should fund 85/15
- Ryan Linqvist: you should always cut to standing rules, cut neutral, in terms of getting sued this is very important. Standing rules establish neutrality. You can give more money, but standing rules must be established. If you take money from agencies you could possibly give more money to student orgs.
- Sen. Mellin: why do we need to cut?
- Sen. Doyle: We would get to give more money to student orgs?
- Sen. Mellin: Would we still be above?
- Ryan Linqvist: we would still be 26 grand up
- Chair Montoya: we have 1,000,580 left, we do have good money left
- Sen. Mellin: Why would we not fund it, we have the money?
- Chair Montoya: It is up to the committee
- Discussion:
 - Sen. Martinez: I think that we should not give the increase reason being that for some of them, they are asking for an increase because of other agencies.
 - Sen. Doyle Motion to call to question
 - Motion failed - split vote - Montoya broke it
 - Sen. Mellin: The thing about the agencies, is that we can just decrease one. I think we are undervaluing their work
 - Sen. Gonzales: While appreciate the value to work ratio. The reasons budgets are flat is to support the budget increase. If we do not pursue increase in wages, consider increasing programming.
 - Sen. Doyle: Something that is on my mind, if we do cut this, we can give more to programming, but they can get that in budget forwards.
 - Ryan Linqvist: Balance forwards used for



other stuff for ec cabinet.

 - Sen. Mellin: we should fund at the dollar, nobody is unqualified
 - Sen. Doyle: Motion to decrease hourly rate to 13.50, line item 11
 - Sen. Mellin: This is unethical
 - Sen. Solorzano: Call to question
